A truly unique duplex apartment occupying the top two floors of this handsome period building, ideally positioned just off Brighton seafront with wonderful sea views and a private roof terrace.

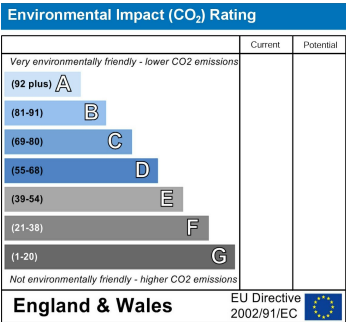
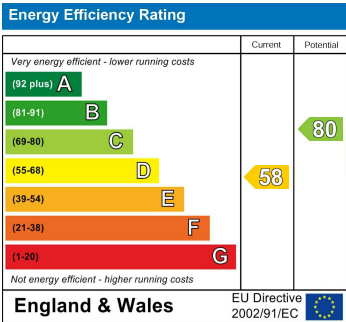
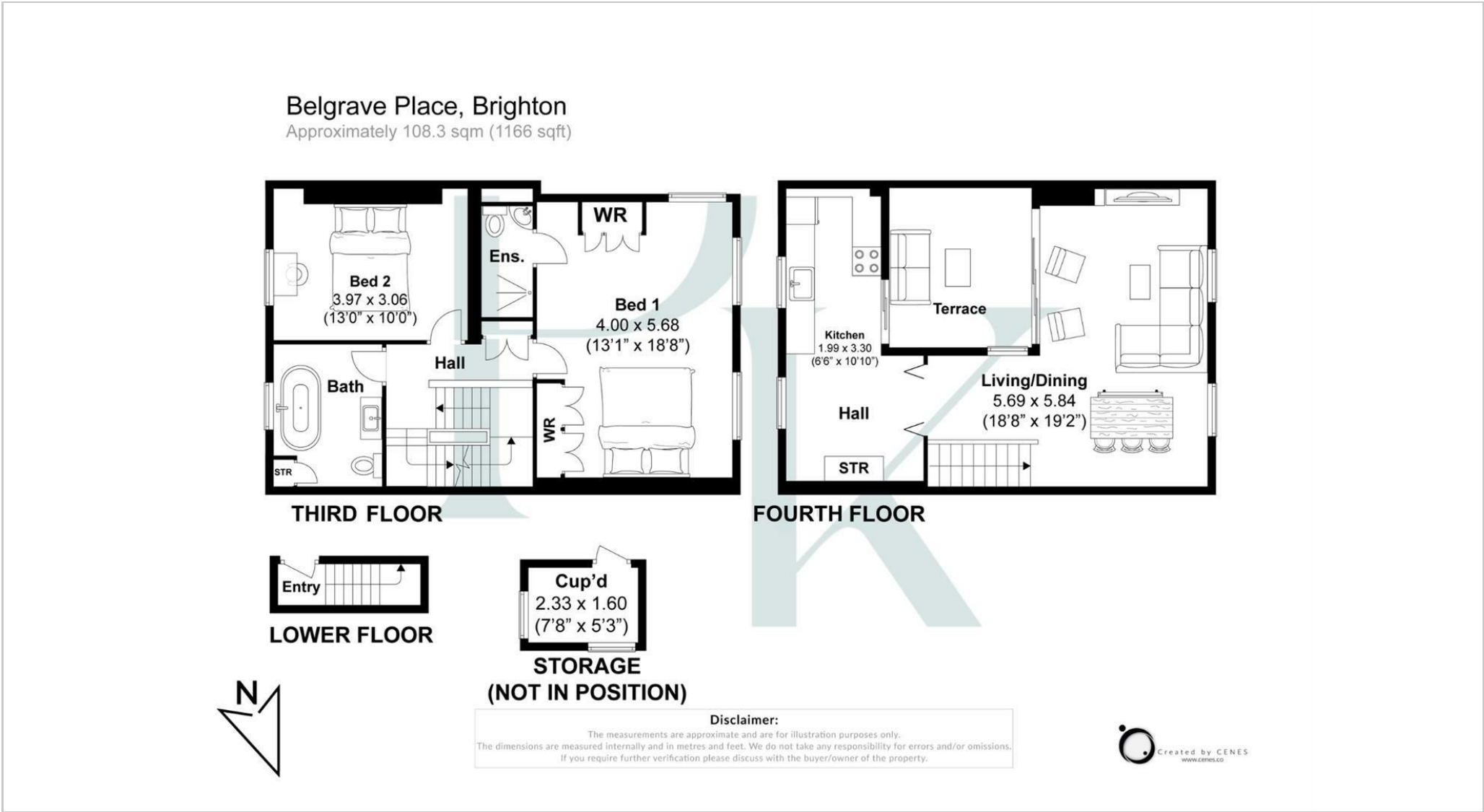
